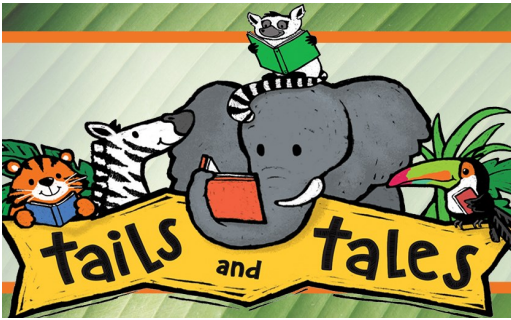
### Tom Wanamaker in Concert Wednesday, July 28 at 7:00 pm

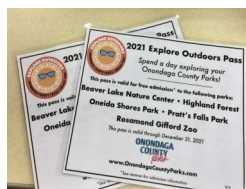


**Nature Kids Yoga with Carrie**
