The summer of 2018 is the summer of **PLANETS!** All our bright planets will be visible in the evening sky at the same time, plus Mars will be making its closest approach to earth until 2035. Come to our early evening astronomy program on Tuesday, August 14 (backup night will be Wednesday, August 15 in case of clouds) to see Venus, Jupiter, Mars and Saturn, plus a crescent moon. Our own resident astronomer Barefoot Bob will have telescopes set up on the library lawn to give close-up views of our solar system's neighbors. Last summer it was the solar eclipse, now come and check out the planets in the night sky! **FREE** and open to all.

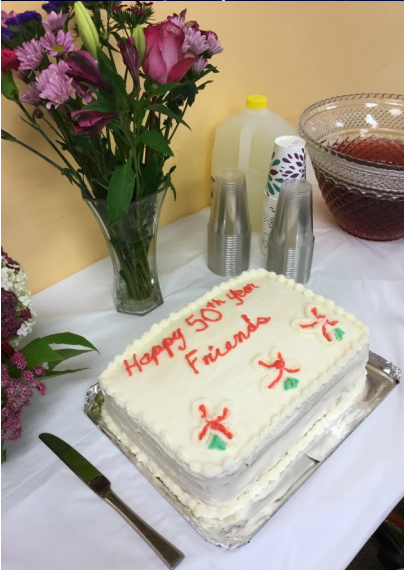

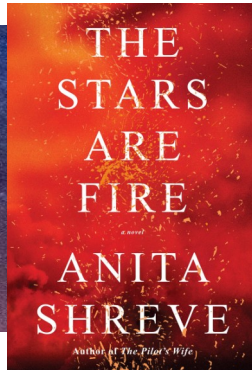
