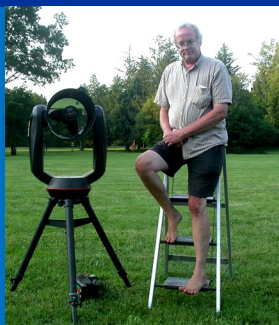
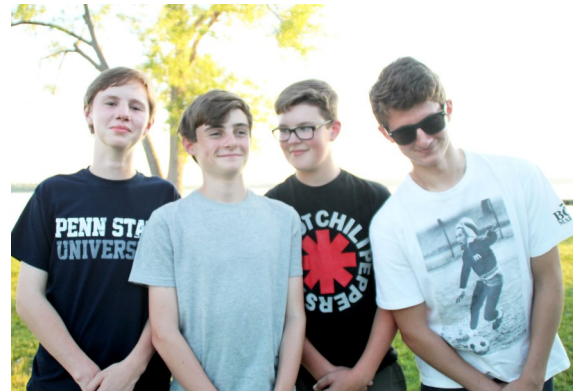


### ***The Big Reveal Celebration*** **Wednesday, August 7 starting at 6:30 pm** **Local History Area**

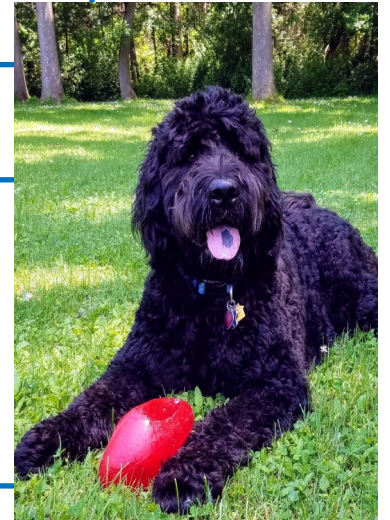

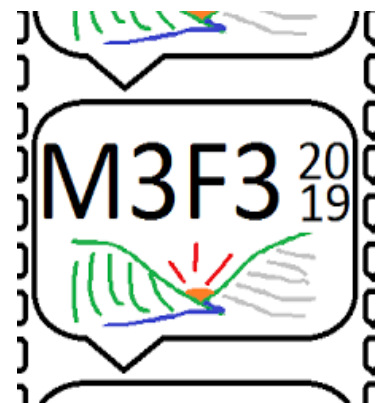

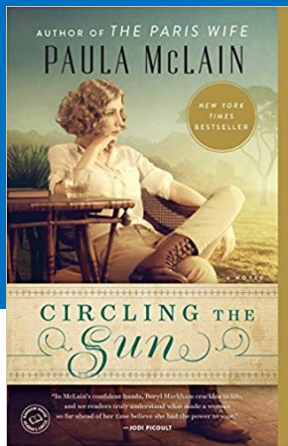


**Monday night is Trading Card Game Night at the library**

**Safe Place to Game Night with Cameron and TCG Player**

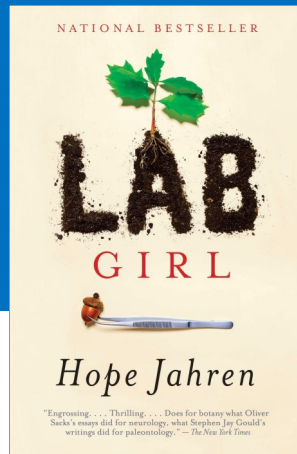
Safe Place to Game is a free community program where students and families can learn and play trading card games like Magic: The Gathering and Pokémon in a judgement-free zone.

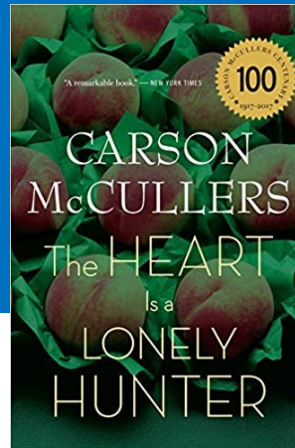

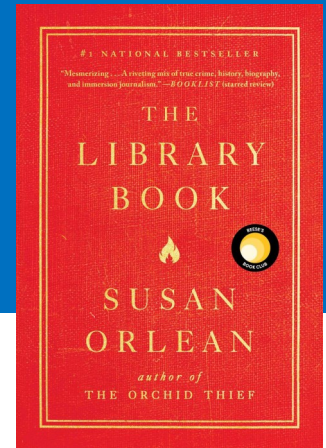
