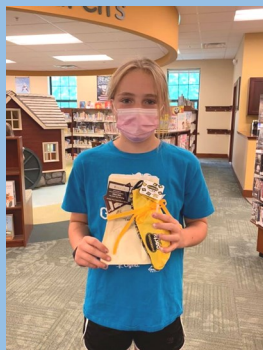
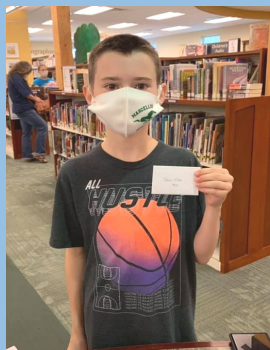

## Summer Astronomy Program with Barefoot Bob Thursday, August 12: 7:00 to 9:30 pm (Back-up date in case of clouds - August 13) Main library parking lot



Join us for a Summer Astronomy program at the Library! Thursday, August 12 is the night when the Perseid meteor shower peaks and we may be treated to a few bright shooting stars when it gets dark. We will start the evening with a look at the crescent moon and Venus, and as they set, we will view the deep-sky objects of the summer Milky Way, and then catch Jupiter and Saturn rising in the east as our program ends.

Bring lawn chairs to sit and watch for meteors when you are not looking through the telescope. We will be turning off the parking lot lights for this program, so walk carefully when it gets dark. Back-up night in case of clouds will be Friday, August 13.

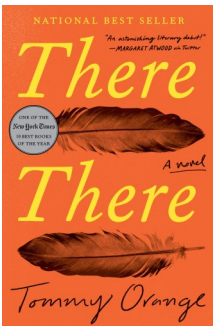

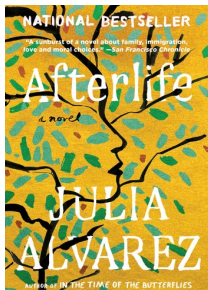
The Marcellus Free Library Book Club meets once a month and is patron led. Newcomers are always welcome for one, some or all of the discussions. Call the library for more information.

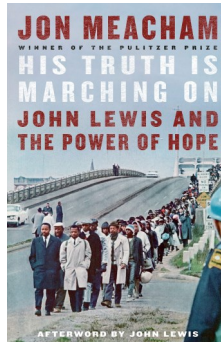

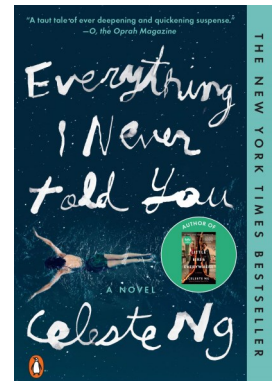
