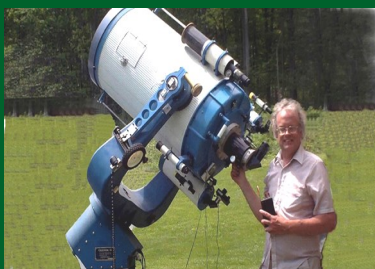


A Message from Director Jake Widrick

December Astronomy with Barefoot Bob Monday, December 13: 5:00 pm to 8:30 pm (Backup night will be Tuesday, December 14)

This is the night of the Geminid meteor shower, one of the year's best. While the bright moon may blot out some of the shooting stars, we will have good views of Jupiter, Saturn, and Venus (come early to see Venus), plus good views of the winter skies around the constellation of Orion, featuring some of the brightest clusters and nebulae visible to us in the north.

Dress warm and bring a lawn chair. Please be aware, we will turn off the parking lot lights for this program.

Winter Teen Craft

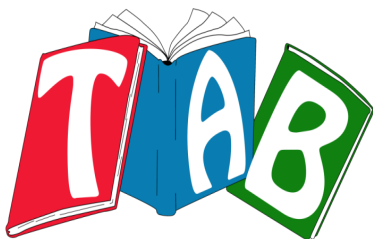

Please bring a yoga mat and thick blanket or towel to use as a prop. Any other yoga accessories you would like to use are welcome as well.

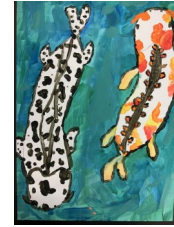
