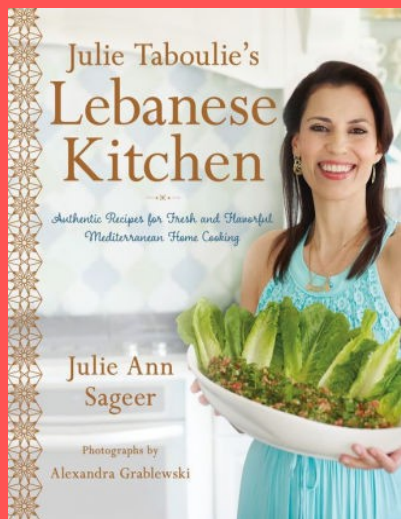

Introduction to Fly Tying with Jim Dewan

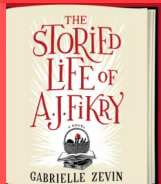
FOUR WEDNESDAY SESSIONS:

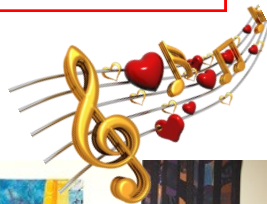
