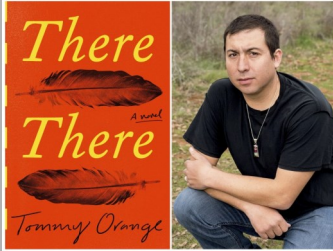


**Winter Astronomy Program with Barefoot Bob**

Everyone is invited for our first ever winter astronomy program with astronomer Bob Piekieł. See the night sky through telescopes as you have never seen it before! Winter skies can be cold, but often give us the clearest, darkest nights that are perfect for star-gazing. At the start of our program, the planet Venus will be sitting near a crescent moon low over the western sky. As they set, the area surrounding the constellation Orion will be rising high in the east. No other section of the sky has as many bright stars, clusters and nebulae as this one. *Please note: the parking lot lights will be turned off for this event, so please be careful driving and walking about.*

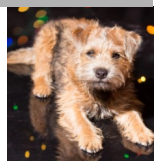

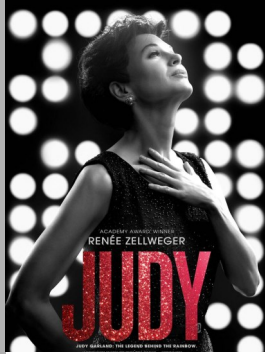

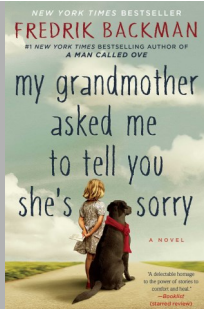
**New Tech Packs now available to borrow**

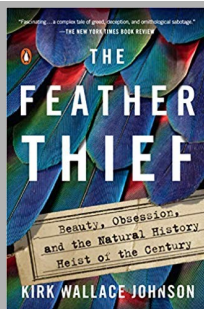

### Marcellus Free Library Book Club meets Wednesday, January 8 at 6:30 pm

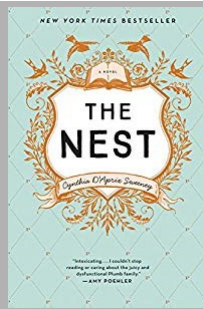
