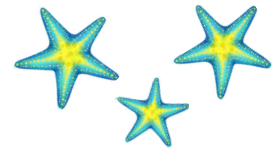

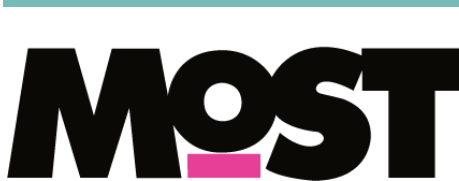

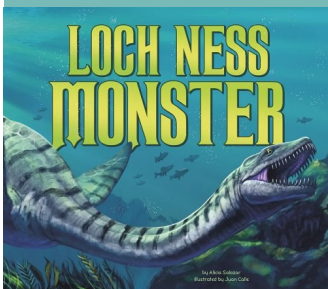


Marine Habitats with the M.O.S.T.

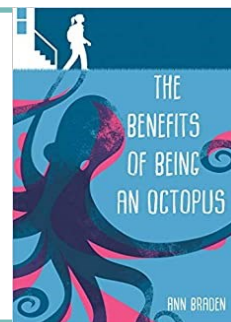


Tween Book Club - 6th through 8th grade only

Come join other tweens for the summer book club at the library. Copies of the book are available for checkout at the circulation desk. Come with your comments, questions and insights from the book!

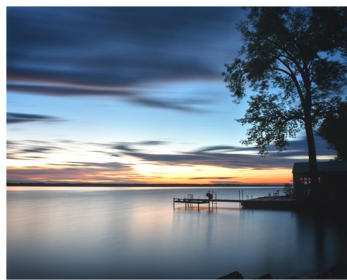
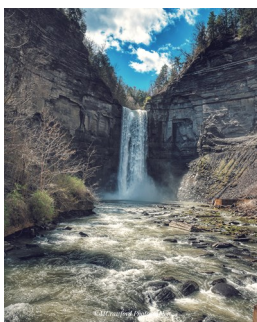
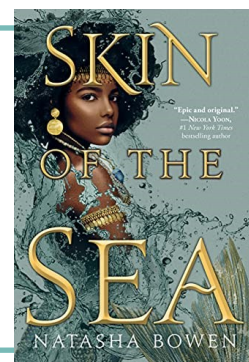
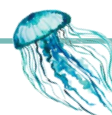


Teen Book Club - 9th through 12th grade only
