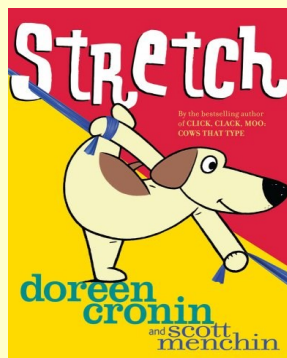

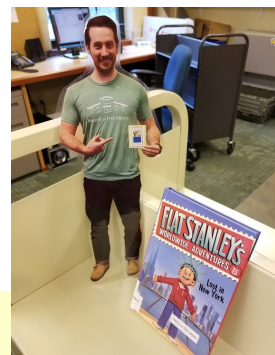

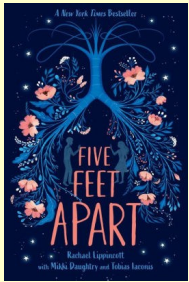




## Adult and Teen 2019 Summer Reading Challenge Program begins July 1 through August 9

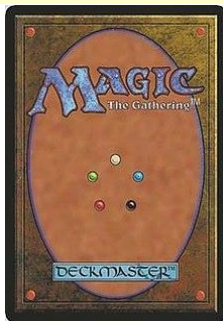
