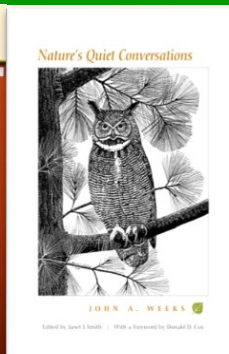

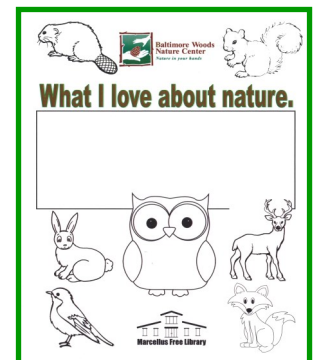

Registration is required. **Please note: There will be no Story Time when the Marcellus schools are closed due to inclement weather.*



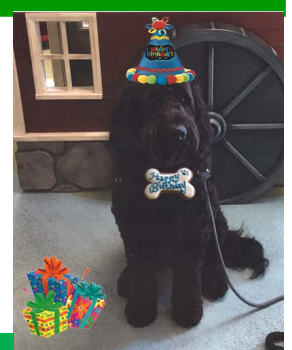
Special Story Time on Children's Nutrition, With Puppets!

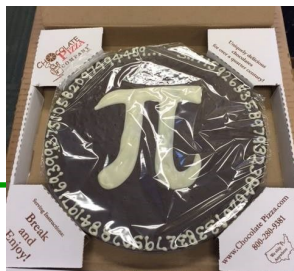
