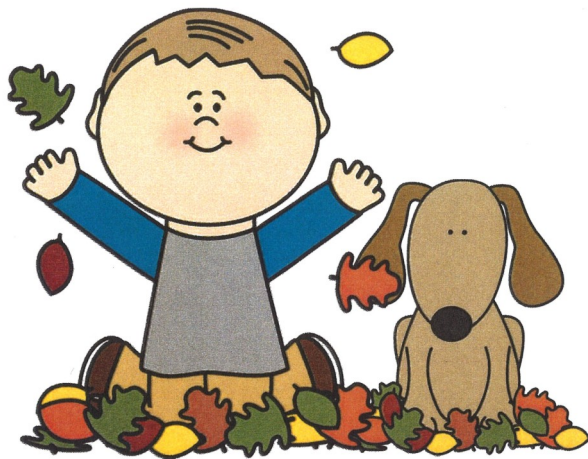


**Fall into Spring - Gardening Workshop with Master Gardener

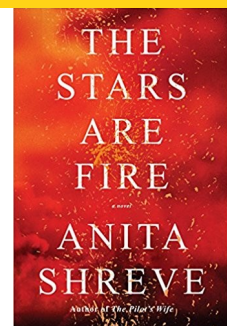
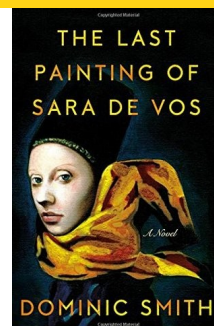
