

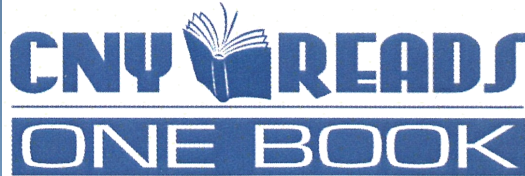

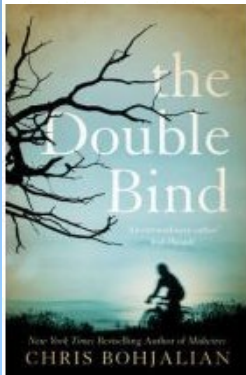

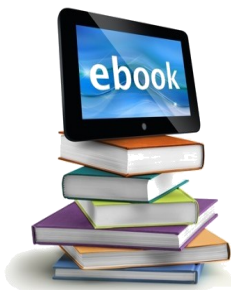

**Ages 13 and up - Registration required, space is limited.**

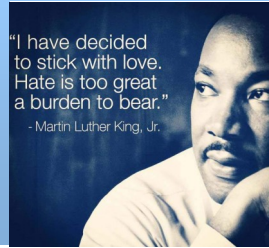

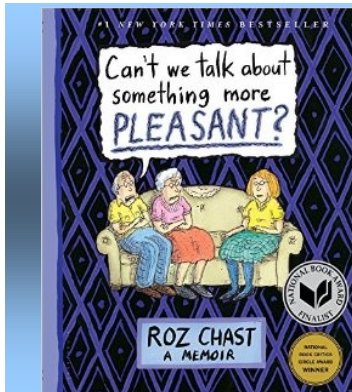
